For several days, therefore, the Institute's new building housed a remarkable concentration of knowledge and experience concerning the problems of the so-called less developed countries, drawn from all over the world. Although it was inevitable that the participants should represent the past (and it was several times remarked that, in that sense, there were too few women present), the earnest and sometimes heated discussions looked to the future as much as to what had happened in the last twenty-five years. As the discussions proceeded, three things became apparent. Firstly, although the papers submitted did not fully reveal it, the ongoing debate between radicals and moderates, those who saw possibilities of change only basically through a direct break with existing structures and those who felt change possible within them, is by no means at an end.
